WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Health & Social Care (Health Sciences & Social Work Pathways) – Level 3 National Extended Diploma

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course develops your knowledge and practical skills within Health and Social Care settings and prepares you for employment in this sector or Higher Education. You are required to complete a minimum of 100 hours work placement (1 day a week) in a hospital, residential care home or any other suitable placement working with adults.
